## NOTICE ON PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data may be collected verbally, in writing or electronically through our website, e-mail or through other mediums.

According to Article 11 of the LPPD, by reaching us through the e-mail address <u>info@amchamturkey.com</u>, you are entitled to request the following with respect to your personal data:

- a) to learn whether the personal data relating to you are being processed,
- b) if it is processed, to request information with regard to processing,
- c) to learn purposes of the processing and whether they are used for such purpose or not;
- d) to know the third persons within or outside the country to whom the personal data are transferred.
- e) to request correction of the personal data if the data is processed incompletely or inaccurately,
- f) to request deletion or destruction of the personal data under the conditions set forth in Article 7 of the LPPD,
- g) to request notifying third persons to whom the personal data are transferred, about the processes completed within the scope of (d) and (e),
- h) to object to negative consequences about you that are concluded as a result of analysis of the processed personal data exclusively by automatic means,
- i) to claim indemnification if the you suffered damage due to illegal processing of your personal data.
